Recognition of Sea Service Aboard Training Vessel S.A. Agulhas for Fishing Cadets.

TO ENGINEER EXAMINERS, HEADS OF MARINE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENTS AT ACCREDITED TRAINING INSTITUTIONS, THE REGISTRAR OF SEAFARERS AND PRINCIPAL OFFICERS

Summary

This Marine Notice explains the recognition of sea service aboard the S.A. Agulhas for fishing candidates.

Fishing candidates serving aboard the vessel S. A. Agulhas for the purpose of furthering their training as an engineer or motorman shall be acknowledged in full to a maximum of 50% of the required sea service for the qualification.

A further 50% of the required sea service on watch in a fishing vessel engine room of applicable kilowattage, academics and workshop training as specified in the Code is required to qualify for acceptance to the level three assessment.
