SUMMARY

To release the procedures and requirements wrt the implementation of the Code of Practice for Bunkering in South African waters.

Following a SAMSA Board decision in line with its legislated mandate the Authority undertakes to process applications in terms of section 21(1)(b) of Marine Pollution (Control and Civil Liability) Act, 1981 (Act No 6 of 1981) (hereinafter 'the Act) pertaining to offshore operations in Algoa Bay and other potential areas, without delay.

This marine notice provides the revised procedures and requirements for obtaining permissions for bunkering operations in Algoa Bay and other potential areas and is issued for a period of public consultation for 21 days. Closing date for comments to the SAMSA Chairperson is 08 March 2024.
